The State Median Income (SMI) is used to establish income eligibility for families receiving child care services as well as to establish family fee amounts based on income and family size. Effective July 1, 2017, at the time of application families who are over 70% of the new SMI for the corresponding family size are over the income limit to receive child care services. Once approved to receive child care subsidy, families who are over 85% of the new SMI for the corresponding family size are over the income limit to receive child care services.

Who is considered an eligible child care provider?

An eligible provider can be one of the following:

- Licensed child care center
- Licensed family day care home
- License-exempt relative or non-relative, legally able to work in the U.S., 18 years of age or older, has been registered and cleared through Trustline (if not the grandparent, aunt or uncle of the child), has completed a Health & Safety Self-Certification, and has no disqualifying felony conviction
